## Financial Update

• Checking Total: \$39,160

- Overall Receivables:
  - 2021 Dues: many payments with pool key signups, including one past due since 2016
  - Overall: 36 homes with past due money on the books (2 arrangements in process; 17 >\$1000); collection rate = 86% paid

#### Pool

Some door issues we have worked through might need to consider a whole new door mechanism in the coming year or two.
