The main topic of discussion at this meeting was how the situation of much of the new sod by the tennis courts being destroyed be handled. There were many ideas and opinions, but a consensus could not be reached. It was decided to table this until the July meeting.

Another important topic was brought up by Robyn Dunlap. She lives on North Campbell and is very worried about the cars speeding on the street. She has taken it upon herself to contact the city about getting Speed Humps at the very least. The city has told her what must happen for the city to even consider putting them in, but she is willing to do the work, with the help of ALL of the residents. - Lawn Care / Greenway
 - Spring Cleanup Day this has been postponed.
 - Dumpsters are coming next Saturday.
 - Payment made with KCMO for 3 dumpsters 2 coming on June 17th (1 for yard waste and 1 for other items); 3rd is October 21st (regular trash)

Clubhouse/Tennis Courts

- Weekend rentals continue to stay busy into the summer.
- Tennis court renovation update: the sod lasted 3 days before a group of older kids played frisbee on it and caused a significant amount of damage. Kyle will be present to walk the board through the options we have discussed to save/replace. Three plans:
 - In any event, spend \$500 on fertilizer and continue watering to get as much of the current sod to take.
 - ~\$3500 (now or fall) to cut out dead sod and lay new/overseed the remaining areas.
 - ~\$6000 (now or fall) to replace ALL sod with new
 - Consider turning it in to insurance as vandalism to recoup cost
- Responsible parent is aware that they may be on the hook for some of this cost. The board needs to determine the percentage of the cost that will be assessed.

 Hard court completion and painting is waiting for the sod plan to solidify before completing.

Social Events

- Friday, June 2nd kickoff to summer went very well. Ice cream plan had to pivot last minute but worked fine and the hot dog cart seemed to do well. Bounce house great as always. HOA had fruit/vegetables/drinks inside. Feedback all very positive.
- Looking to do another similar event on Friday, July 7th.
- o Movie nights are waiting on the status of the hard court completion.
